# "Mother's Day"

February 2014 Aurifil Designer's Challenge Block


Finished block size is $12^{\prime \prime}$ - all seams are stitched $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, right sides of fabric together

## Cutting:

- White: 1 square $8.25^{\prime \prime}$
- White: 8 squares $3.25^{\prime \prime}$
- Print 1 (red): 1 square $8.25^{\prime \prime}$
- Varied prints of your choice (for half square triangle)- 8 squares 3.25" (for my block, I broke this down as 3 squares of the red check, 3 squares of the red text, and 1 square each of 2 blues, totally 8 squares)


## Construction:

1. Using a ruler, draw a diagonal line, corner to opposite corner, on the wrong side of each white square (both the larger and smaller squares).

2. Pair each white square with a print square of the same size, right sides together, pin, and stitch a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on either side of the drawn line (not on the line itself).
3. Cut on the drawn line, creating 2 units from each pair. You will now have 16 small units, and 2 large units. Discard 1 of the larger units, or save for another project- you will only need 1 for this block.

4. Press each unit open, with the seam allowance facing toward the darker fabric, then trim off the dog ears. The smaller units should each measure $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square, and the larger unit should measure $75 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Excess will be minimal, if any, but trim if needed.

5. To assemble the block, lay out your half square triangle units using the block image as a guide, then stitch units together following the diagram below. Take care to align and pin seam intersections

6. Lastly, square block to $12.5^{\prime \prime}$ as needed.
