From Dark/Medium Scraps cut:

7 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" A Squares

2 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" B Rectangles (matched set)

2 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" C Squares (matched set that matches B Rectangles)

1 - 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" square cut in half once diagonally as shown creating two D Triangles:

(you will only need one D Triangle for each block)



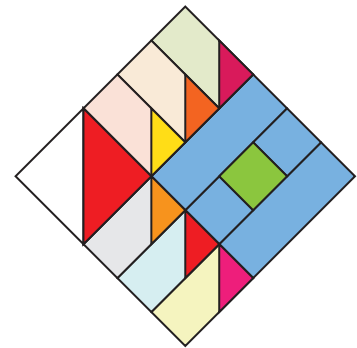
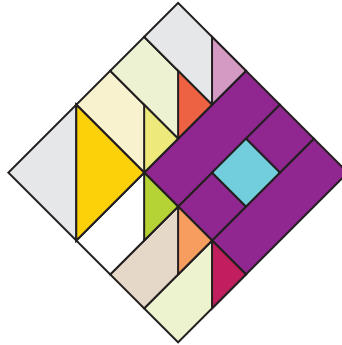
From Light Scraps cut:

1 - 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" square cut in half once diagonally as shown creating two E Triangles:

(you will only need one E Triangle for each block)



6 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" F Rectangles

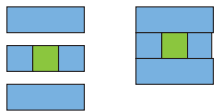


Sew it up

1. Sew each of the matching C Squares to each side of an A Square as shown:



2. Sew B Rectangles on the top and bottom of the C/A/C unit as shown:



3. Sew one of the D Triangles to one of the E Triangles:



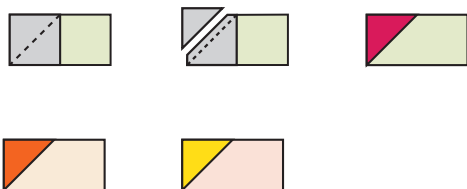
4. Place one A Square on one of the F Rectangles, sew as indicated by dotted line. Trim, and press A Square out as shown:



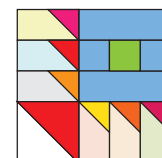
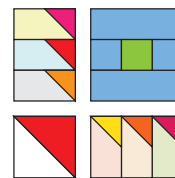
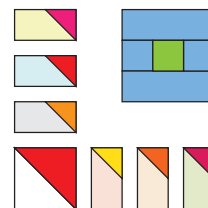
5. Make two more A/F units as in Step 4.



6. Reverse Steps 4 and 5 creating 3 Reverse A/F units:



7. Combine A/B/C unit with D/E units sans A/F units as shown:



8. Now Go Make More!
