# Chain Links (Aurifil June Block)

## 12" Square

Please read all instructions before starting. Measurement on borders are approximate. Measure your quilt top before cutting.

Use a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise noted.

# **Cutting Instructions:**

#### Fabric A

• Cut (1) 6 1/2" square.

#### Fabric B

• Cut (6) 3 1/2" squares.

#### Fabric C

• Cut (6) 3 ½" squares.

#### Fabric D

• Cut (4) 2" squares.

#### Fabric E

- Cut (4) 2" squares;
- Cut (4) 2" x 3 ½" strips.



# **Block Assembly Instructions:**

Place one 3 ½" Fabric B square on the top left corner of one 6 ½" Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam.

Pollow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 3 ½" Fabric B square to the lower right corner of the 6 ½" Fabric A square.

Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a 3 ½" Fabric C square to the upper right and lower left corner of the 6 ½" Fabric A square to complete the Block Center (Fig. 5).



- Sew one 2" Fabric D square, one 2" Fabric E square and one 2" x 3 ½" Fabric E strip together to make the upper left corner (Fig. 6). Repeat to make the lower right corner.
- Sew one 2" Fabric D square, one 2" Fabric E square and one 2" x 3 ½" Fabric E strip together to make the upper right corner (Fig. 7). Repeat to make the lower left corner.



6. Follow Figure 8 to sew, the four corner blocks, block center, four 3 ½" Fabric C squares and four 3 ½" Fabric B squares to make the 12 ½" square block.


