Tossed Salad is a Modern block with traditional parts. Anyway you toss it you get a fresh salad of color and dash!

## Cutting Instructions:

From Red print cut:
$1-4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Square A
$1-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Square B
1-2 $1 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2$ " Rectangle C
From Green solid cut:
7 - $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Rectangle C
From White solid cut:
$1-4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Square A
2-3 $1 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2 "$ Rectangle D
$16-21 / 2 " \times 21 / 2 "$ Square B
From Blue print cut:
1-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Rectangle E
$1-1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " Rectangle F
$2-1 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times 31 / 2 "$ Rectangle G

## Make the Geese blocks first:

1. On the wrong side of each of the White Square B's mark a line lightly with a pencil from corner to corner as shown:

2. Lay White Square B on one side of the Red Rectangle C, right sides together, and sew along the pencil line:

3. Cut away the excess corner and press

White Square to the corner:

4. Repeat with another White Square B on the other side:

5. Repeat Steps 2-4 with the 7 Green Rectangle C's and the remaining White Square B's.


## Toss your Salad Block together:

Sew the Geese blocks together with the remaining Squares and Rectangles as shown:
