Something Fishy

Block > 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished

From Dark/Medium Scraps cut:

- $7 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " A Squares
- $2-2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " B Squares (matched set)
- 2 2 ½" x 6 ½" C Rectangles (matching B Squares)
- 1 5" x 5" Square cut in half once diagonally as shown creating 2 D Triangles: (you will only need one D Triangle for each block)





From Background Fabric (all one fabric or Scrappy) cut:

 $1-5\mbox{``}$ x 5" Square cut in half once diagonally as shown creating 2 E Triangles: (you will only need one E Triangle for each block)





6 – 2 ½" x 4 ½" F Rectangles

Sew it up

1. Sew each of the matching C Squares to each side of an A Square as shown:









2. Sew B Rectangles on the top and bottom of the C/A/C unit as shown:





3. Sew one of the D Triangles to one of the E Triangles:





Trim to 4 ½" Square

4. Place one A Square on one of the F Rectangles, sew as indicated by dotted line. Trim, and press A Square out as shown:







5. Make two more A/F units as in Step 4.





6. Reverse Steps 4 and 5 creating 3 Reverse A/F units:
